THE HELEN G. POHLING SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Helen G. Pohling Trust Fund was established by Ilse O. Buckner in honor of her mother, Helen G. Pohling. It is a scholarship fund administered by the Davenport Schools Foundation.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must graduate from a Davenport Community high school by June 30, 2012. Recipients must be enrolled for the 2012-2013 term in an accredited two or four-year college or university in the United States.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection of recipients is based on academic achievement (no less than 24 ACT and 3.25 G.P.A.), extra-curricular activities, moral character, and other conditions considered appropriate by the Selection Committee. All selections will be made on an objective and non-discriminatory basis.

AWARD

Three scholarships will be awarded for the 2012-2013 academic year, with one recipient from each of the three Davenport Community high schools. Awards are for one year only and will be applied toward tuition, books and fees. The amount of the award is approximately \$1,200.

APPLICATIONS

Application forms are available in the Guidance offices at Central, North and West high schools. Completed applications must be turned in to the Guidance Office on or before Friday, March 2, 2012.
