8th GRADE TRANSFER OPTION REQUESTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL OF CHOICE

Eighth grade students will be registering for high school during the month of January. Central HS will visit Sudlow on Jan. 19th and North HS will be here on Jan. 26th to register students for their freshman year.

The Davenport Community School District will allow students to attend the high school of their choice. However, a transfer option form must be filled out and returned for

approval, prior to being allowed to attend a school outside of resident attendance boundaries. Any Sudlow student who plans on attending a school that will require transfer option approval is encouraged to complete the form as soon as possible. Forms are available in the Guidance Office. We encourage Sudlow students to return the form to our building and we will forward it to the Administrative Service Center.
