Note From The School Nurse:

With your written permission your student will be able to receive, at no cost, the Tdap vaccine at school. Nurses from the health department are scheduled to be at Sudlow on Tuesday April 13 to give free Tdap immunizations. The Scott County Health Department will be mailing letters to the addresses that are on file with the school district. The mailing will take place during our spring break. The letter will contain information about Tdap and consent forms. *If your address has changed please make sure to update our office at Sudlow with your correct contact information.* A Vaccine Information Statement will be included in the letter you will be receiving; please review it. Tdap Vaccine provides an opportunity to protect your child from Pertussis (Whooping cough), tetanus and diphtheria.

A Reminder for all 8th Grade Students:

All incoming 9th grade students and students new to the DCSD from out of State are required by Iowa law to have proof of a dental exam within the past year. This record must be turned into the school nurse on an Iowa Dental Certificate as soon as possible. Please contact your dentist or school nurse for questions.
